# Course Objectives

After completing the course, the candidates will understand the indications and contraindications for ECMO, and the practical skills required for initiating and providing ongoing ECMO support.

Using High fidelity Simulation to recreate real life situations that occur during an ECMO run, candidates will learn the practical and teamwork, leadership and communication skills required to managed this complex system and enable the candidates to gain experience and mechanisms to cope with the potentials of real life situations, all in a completely free of risk environment. All the contents of the scenarios and the clinical algorithms used to solve it are in line with the ELSO guidelines for the management of neonatal and pediatric cardio-respiratory failure.
